



CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

1st Latin American Regional Meeting on Dental Trauma – 2025

The Scientific Committee of the 1st Latin American Regional Meeting on Dental Trauma (TRAUMACON) hereby announces this call for the submission and presentation of scientific papers in an in-person format, aiming to select papers to be presented at TRAUMACON on May 22 and 23, 2025.

I – INSTRUCTIONS FOR REGISTRATION AND ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

Abstract submissions will be open from **March 12, 2025, to April 1, 2025, at 11:59 PM.**

Registration and payment for the event are mandatory for abstract submission. Payment processing may take up to three days. The abstract must be submitted at the time of registration through the following link: <https://sistemas.fau.org.br/participante/index.xhtml?idevento=978>

Each individual may present **only one abstract** but can be listed as a co-author on multiple submissions. At the time of abstract submission, the author must indicate their **academic level**: Undergraduate or Graduate (Master's/PhD).

Abstract must fall within the **Oral and maxillofacial trauma** field and be classified into one of the following **thematic areas**:

1. Clinical Research
2. Laboratory and Animal Research
3. Epidemiological Research
4. Case Report
5. Experience Reports
6. Reviews

The list of accepted abstract will be published on **April 14, 2025**, on the Instagram page (@traumacon.latinamerica) and the event website (<https://www.traumacon2025.com>).

II – PREPARING TO SUBMIT AN ABSTRACT

For abstract preparation, authors must strictly follow the formatting model available at: https://docs.google.com/document/d/1EFQ4bPqYFe_6LWMNN38MyDAa2EOt00pW/edit

- **Title**: Bold, Times New Roman, size 11, 1.0 spacing, maximum 120 characters (excluding spaces), with only the first letter capitalized and no period at the end.

- **Authors**: Separated by commas, no spacing between initials. Maximum of 8 authors. Example: Oliveira JA*, Soares PBF, Pigossi SC. The presenter must be the first author and responsible for the submission. The asterisk should be placed after the last name and initials of the first author.

- **Institution**: Each author's institution must be indicated using superscript numbers and listed below the author names.

- **Abstract**: Maximum 1,350 characters (excluding spaces). It must be structured, including Objectives or Purpose, Methods, Results, and Conclusions. These sections must not be explicitly labeled but should be clearly outlined in the text. If applicable, financial support should not be included in the conclusion section but in the designated funding field.

- **Keywords**: Select three descriptors according to Health Sciences Descriptors (DeCS) or MeSH terms that best identify the content of your work.





IMPORTANT: The abstract must not exceed 1,470 characters (excluding spaces), with 120 characters for the title and 1,350 for the abstract body. Abstracts may be submitted in Portuguese, English, or Spanish.

Any **research project involving humans, animals, genetically modified organisms (GMOs), or their components** (including surveys, patient records, archives, and protocols) must be reviewed and approved by the appropriate Ethics Committee. The approval certificate must be uploaded at the time of submission. For **case reports and experience reports**, authors must complete and upload a declaration form (available at: https://docs.google.com/document/d/1jojzATH_dMhwT9XwTYQ4-VtvL9HIClaM/edit). This document must confirm that the study complies with Brazilian Resolution CNS No. 466/2012 and/or Resolution CNS No. 510/2016 and its complementary regulations.

III – PRESENTATIONS

All presentations will be conducted as **electronic posters** in the event meeting room at Nobile Suites Uberlândia (Rondon Pacheco Avenue, 3500, Saraiva, Uberlândia, MG, Brazil) on **May 22 and 23, 2025, from 12:00 PM to 2:00 PM.**

The schedule and room assignments will be announced by **May 15, 2025**, on the Instagram page (@traumacon.latinamerica) and the event website (<https://www.traumacon2025.com>).

The **electronic poster** must be submitted using the **designated template** provided alongside the list of accepted papers. Each presentation is limited to 5 minutes, followed by a 5-minute Q&A session with the review panel.

The presentations PDF must be submitted via the Google Forms link <https://acesse.one/MG5Wp> by **May 5, 2025, at 11:59 PM.** The event committee is not responsible for any technical issues during submission.

IV – CRITERIA FOR PRESENTATION EVALUATION, CERTIFICATION, AND AWARDS

Presenters will be evaluated based on posture, presentation timing, scientific knowledge, applied scientific or clinical methods, presentation and interpretation of results and alignment between the abstract and presentation content. Certificates will be available at <https://www.sieux.proexc.ufu.br> after the event.

Best papers in each category will receive an honorable mention certificate at the awards ceremony on **May 23, 2025.**
